Students are expected to arrive in a timely fashion so that rehearsal may begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. Ruthellen Brooks will be directing the Littlest Angels, and Sachi DeWinter will be accompanying them.

The <u>Muscatine Children's Choir</u>, consisting of students in 3rd-8th grade, will also meet every Monday from 4:00 to 4:45 p.m. at Wesley, starting on September 13. Dr. Laaveg will be directing Children's Choir. Sally Potter, Organist and Assistant Director of Music at Wesley, will be accompanying them.
