

God's arms are always stretched open wide to welcome the wandering ones home. In # Jesus Christ your sins are forgiven, where you have a place in God's house forever.



Readings: Isaiah 55:1-9; Psalm 63:1-8; 1 Corinthians 10:1-13


In response to the readings:







LORD'S PRAYER


Gathered into one by the Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:

COMMUNION DISTRIBUTION
